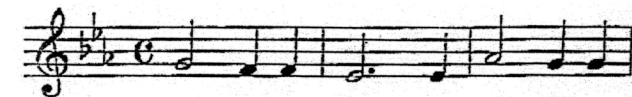

**People (sung)** *Lord, hear our prayer.*

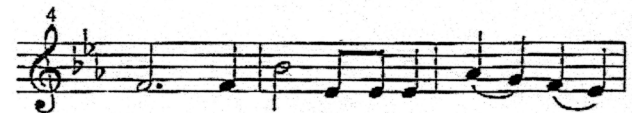

**People (sung)** *Lord, hear our prayer.*

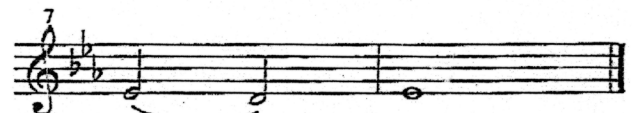
